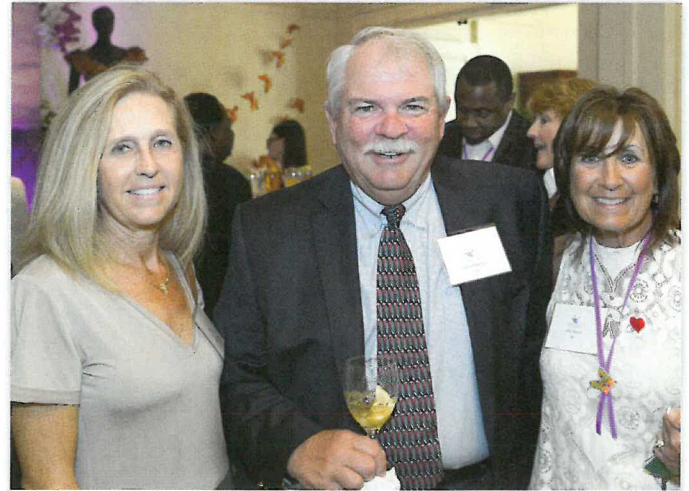




## MENDING BROKEN HEARTS WITH HOPE

The Shelter for Abused Women & Children held its 17th annual “Mending Broken Hearts with Hope” luncheon at The Ritz-Carlton Golf Resort, Naples. Proceeds from the luncheon, which included a silent auction, designer boutique and keynote presentation by NFL Vice President Troy Vincent, went to support the shelter’s mission. Vincent gave a heart-warming speech, calling on men to share in his commitment of raising awareness, aimed at stopping and preventing abuse. The luncheon raised more than \$730,000 to support the programs and services that The Shelter for Abused Women & Children provide, including operating a 60-bed emergency shelter, seven transitional cottages and numerous outreach and prevention programs. Money raised will also benefit the new Immokalee-based Shelly Stayer Shelter, which will serve victims of human trafficking, as well as domestic violence.

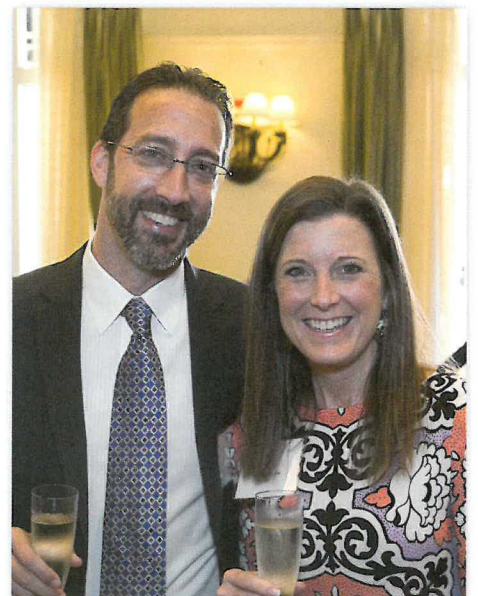
